Facade Engineering: Delivering the Architecture

In a time where the design of buildings need to respond to the Sustainability agenda and the challenges of Climate Change and the Credit Crunch, the success of architectural projects depends more than ever on the ability of designers and contractors to develop appropriate solutions.

Successful designs will often seamlessly integrate aesthetics and functionality in a way which responds to the Client's requirements as well as project-specific constraints and opportunities. When dealing with non-conventional building envelopes, it is paramount that concepts are being designed with fabrication and installation in mind. At the same time, the ability to understand the language and the aspirations of the Architect and the Client is a prerequisite in order to respond to the architectural vision.

Facade engineering potentially offers to bridge the widening gap between the traditional disciplines, bringing specialist knowledge throughout the different stages of a project. Timely advice and a pro-active approach will often both maximise the value of a project and minimise the risk associated with the design of the building envelope. Procurement models vary and different projects require different approaches, but generally facade engineering can bring out the architecture through appropriate solutions rather than compromising the architecture through under-designed or unintegrated solutions.

Three distinguished speakers will give different perspectives on facade engineering and architectural design. Through illustrative case studies, the speakers will demonstrate how facade engineering can facilitate integration and enhance architectural solutions to the benefit of Client, Designers, Contractors, and End Users.
